Washington Township Park Rules and Regulations

1. Fees: \$50.00 per day for a large pavilion or amphitheater, \$30 per day for a small pavilion (please see definitions of large and small pavilions below), and a refundable deposit of \$100.00 to cover any violation of the rules and regulations or additional costs that the Township may incur because of renting the structure to the signatory below. Renting multiple structures will require payment of a fee and deposit for each additional structure rented. The decision to refund all, part, or none of the deposit is solely Washington Township's. Any amount required above and beyond the rental fee(s) and deposit(s) will be paid by the applicant immediately upon receipt to Washington Township. Refund of deposit, if any, will be decided at the first of the month during the normal Washington Township Council meeting. Refund (if any) may be picked up the following day after the council meeting.
2. Any group greater than 25 persons using Park facilities **MUST** obtain permission at least seven (7) days in advance.
3. One Porta-Potty is provided by the Township. Any event of 50 persons or greater **MUST** obtain one additional porta-potty for each group of 50 people or faction thereof, at their own expense, and provide the Township proof of the rental prior to the event.
4. Grass areas may not be used as roadways, parking, or for other purposes which may deface the turf or landscape.
5. Flora and fauna residing within the parks must not be injured, damaged, harassed, or otherwise defaced in any manner.
6. Township buildings, fences, fountains, benches, walls, posts, signs, or other exterior features or infrastructure must not be damaged or defaced. **No staples, tacks, nails, or other permanent holders to be used on tables, posts, or any part of the pavilion, amphitheater, benches, or other park features or infrastructure.**
7. Paper, rubbish, glass bottles, cigarettes, or any kind of refuse must be deposited in receptacles provided for that purpose. Do not leave any trash in or around receptacles; **take out everything you brought in.**
8. Fires may only be built in stoves, grilles, or fire rings originally created and brought for that purpose. **No improvised fire containers or cooking mechanisms allowed. No open fires, grills, or fryers to be used under pavilion roofs.**
9. Tables must remain under pavilion roofs. Any table that is moved is to be returned to its original location.
10. Do not dump any grease or oil substances (food related or otherwise) in the receptacles, waterways, or grounds of the parks.
11. Picnic reservations are permitted only in locations stated on the reservation form. The reservation fee entitles your group the exclusive use of the rented picnic area, **NOT the entire park.**
12. No trespassing on private property surrounding the park.
13. Harassment of other park patrons is strictly prohibited.
14. Public meetings, assemblages, or parades may not take place within the park limits without written consent of Washington Township. This includes any organized group conducting activities within the park.
15. **The maximum speed limit in the entire park is 15 miles per hour.**
16. We make no guarantees for weather condition at the parks.

No exceptions to the rules-violators will be removed from park.
