

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES June 2nd, 2026

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Campbell called the Washington Township Council Meeting to order on June 2, 2026, at 6:30 P.M. at the Washington Township Administration Building at 11800 Edinboro Road, Edinboro, PA.
