12. NEW BUSINESS –

- A. Zoning Map Change request, R-1 to C1 NE corner of 6N & Fry Road.
 - Defer to Planning and schedule a public hearing, earliest date October 6th, possibly October 20th.
- B. Darcy & Jeff Karickhoff property, located at 12231 Rt. 99, (45) 13-21-2.01, 1 new lot created. Asking to waive preliminary and proceed to final approval.
- C. Tax liability \$684.85 on donated parcel surrounding Dollar General. Difficult to track down owner, sold the DG property, likely cost more in legal fees than just paying taxes due – Solicitor agrees
- D. PURTA reimbursement, see attachment.
 - PURTA is a state tax paid by certain utility companies that are regulated by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) or a similar agency.
Instead of paying local real estate taxes, these companies pay PURTA to the state. The state then distributes money to local governments (counties, municipalities, school districts) to make up for those lost local taxes.

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NEW BUSINESS - Continued

- E. Wal-Mart traffic light has no generator connection. When power goes out light stops functioning. Dangerous. We get notified by PSP, employees go to light, place foldable sawhorse with stop signs attached. 6N travelers do not stop, chaos ensues. Cost of new generator, installed on our prepared site: \$10,200 by Wm T. Spaeder (COSTARS). Solicitor has the agreements, poorly written, recommends we proceed with installation, and parallel track of seeking some reimbursement from tenants.
- F. Vehicle dash cam's and GPS
- G. Water Department hydrant sandblasting:
- Proud finish mobile sandblasting \$2,200 – turnkey sandblasting.
 - Sunbelt rentals \$1,900/week for unit plus \$37/bag (3 bags/hydrant; worst 16 of 42 hydrants; \$1,776)
 - Waiting on other quotes.
 - Dustin will paint the clean hydrants.
